The initial idea was to create a building that be opened to the surrounding environment. Two impressive curved stone walls form the basic structure of the architectural composition, defining the best views, orientation, sunlight and protecting the building from the strong winds.

These stone walls meet in the entrance of the building forming the hall and are organized around the cylindrical volume of the staircase. They also enclose and arrange the various program activities on three levels on both sides of the hall.

On the ground floor, common use spaces are located; bar, restaurant, lounge, a pro-shop and the office. The restaurant, which combines wood, stone flooring and illuminated walls, gives access to a covered terrace by canvas and a bbq area. In the basement; the changing rooms, a parking to keep the electric cars and various storage places. On the roof, an opened terrace-bar with $360\ ^{\circ}$ views to be use on summer.

A circular ramp allows an alternative access, creating a garden that is only visible from the changing rooms. The use of materials such as stone, plaster, corten- steel and wood establishes a relationship between the building and the setting. The landscaping project was inspired by existing elements and native vegetation.
